IAAE HISTORY

The International Association of Airport Executives (IAAE) is an affiliated organization of the American Association of Airport Executives (AAAE). AAAE, founded in 1928, is a not-for-profit association and the largest professional organization for airport executives in the world, representing airport management personnel at more than 850 public-use airports worldwide. After its inception and for many decades to come, AAAE focused on its primary goal of assisting airport executives in fulfilling their responsibilities to the airports and communities they serve.
